RIPPA RUGBY

Hautapu Sports Club provide Rippa Rugby for Years 1 & 2. This takes place at Memorial Park and is played at Leamington once a month. These games are played on a Friday night and kick off is at 4.30pm, and 5.10pm. Rippa play 15minute halves with a 5min half time break.

TACKLE RUGBY

Tackle Rugby is offered to years 3-6. Hautapu Sports Club is part of the Waikato Wide Junior Rugby sub union and play on a Saturday morning at once of the following venues – Memorial Park, Leamington, Hinuera, Morrinsville/Kereone, Matamata, Tokoroa and Putaruru. These games are usually played between 9am and 12pm depending on the draw. Tackle grades play 20min halves with a 5min half time break. These games are played with 10 players a side on reduced size fields. Our 11th grade sides (year 6) play on a full field with 15 players.

NOTE: All intermediate aged players register through CJRS.

Junior Hockey Information:

Hautapu Sports Club provide hockey for children in Year 3 to Year 6. Teams play in two grades, one for Year 3/4 teams and one for Year 5/6 teams. All Hautapu Sports Club Junior Hockey teams are entered into the Cambridge Mini Hockey module.

Games are played on Friday afternoons and evenings at the St Peters School Hockey Turf, 1716 Cambridge Road, Cambridge. We endeavour to keep school groups together as much as possible.

The season consists of 13 playing weeks. Refer to season start, end and no play dates above. Draws will be sent out to all registered players when they are available. Weekly draws can be found on the Hautapu Sports Club website (www.hautapusports.co.nz), Waikato Hockey website (https://www.waikatohockey.org.nz/), through PlayHQ and Cambridge Mini Hockey Facebook page.

Intermediate Hockey information:

Hautapu Sports Club provide hockey for children in Year 7 and Year 8. Teams are entered into the Waikato Hockey Association Intermediate Competition (Year 7/8). Games are played on Friday afternoons and evenings at various locations around Hamilton, as listed below. All players, from Years 7 & 8 are eligible to play. Teams play half-field, 6-a-side games. Some teams play 6-a-side without a goalie, and some play 6-a-side plus a goalie. The season consists of 14 playing weeks. Refer to season start, end and no play dates above.

Teams will be emailed out by Friday 29th March 2025. In this email there will be a link to register with PlayHQ. This is a Waikato Hockey requirement. You only have to do this full registration once, in subsequent years it is much easier and quicker as your details will be saved in the system.

Fees for the 2025 primary and intermediate hockey season are noted under the fee section. Payment will be required upon registration. We do understand however that some people may wish to make a payment arrangement which is absolutely fine. If this is the case, please email juniorhockey@hautapusports.com.

Uniform:

All players will need Hautapu Sports Club socks, Hautapu Shorts Club shorts, shinpads, a mouthguard and a hockey stick. Playing shirts will be provided for the season. We have a limited number of hockey sticks that are available to borrow for the season.

F. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How can I register for the 2025 Season?

Registrations for ALL SPORTS must be made online, via the Club's Friendly Manager website. For each code, this does differ slightly, and you will be required to complete a new registration form each year. For more detailed information regarding the registration process, please refer to 'E. REGISTRATION PROCESS' below.

2. Can I still register for a sport after registrations have closed?

You will need to reach out to your sport director – refer to the contacts below. Late registrations may be subject to an additional late registration fee.

3. What are the fees for the 2025 season?

The fees for each season are reviewed annually and discussed in detail by the club committee to ensure fairness across the board. You will find the registration fees applicable to each code under 'C. SEASON FEES' below

4. Why have some of the code fees increased since 2025?

This is to ensure that all sport code associated costs are covered throughout the year. Each code fee represents the associated costs relevant to that specific code including the below...

- a. Affiliation fees
- b. Umpire / ref fees
- c. Apparel fees (team uniform costs)
- d. Club and maintenance fees
- e. General administration
- f. Subscription fees
- g. Equipment & resources
- h. Prizegiving expenses

5. Do I have to purchase apparel to play in a team?

If your sport requires you to wear club apparel, you must do so. These can be purchased through your registration process or through the shop on the club website. Please refer to 'D. TEAM APPAREL' for more information.

6. How do I volunteer to coach or manage a team?

In the registration process there will be an option to opt in to volunteer. You can select your preferred volunteer position under the tab. If you would like to volunteer at the club but the option suited to you isn't listed, please reach out to gmanager@hautapusports.com

G. SPORT SPECIFIC REGISTRATION PLATFORMS

(These are additional to the Hautapu Registration process)

RUGBY XPLORER REGISTRATIONS:

If you are signing up for the first time in Rugby Xplorer, follow the steps below. When signing up a family, we recommend selecting the parent as the primary account holder.

- 1. Download the Rugby Xplorer app
- 2. Click "Create a Rugby Xplorer account"
- 3. Select your Rugby National.
 - a. Note, this will default to your country based on the geolocation of your device.
- 4. Enter First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, Phone Number and Email Address.
- 5. Read and agree to the Rugby Xplorer Privacy Policy and your National's Privacy Policy.
- 6. Click "Next"
- 7. If there are profiles that might be you, they will display on screen, where you can select the record and claim your account.
- 8. If there are no matching profiles, Rugby Xplorer will send you a sign in link.
- 9. Check your email for your 'Welcome to Rugby Xplorer' email.
 - a. Don't forget to check your junk or spam emails.
- 10. Click the "Verify Email" button in the email.
- 11. Set your password, by entering it in twice, click "Confirm".
 - a. Your password needs to have a minimum of 10 characters with at least 1 uppercase letter, 1 lowercase letter and 1 number and 1 special character.
- 12. You will receive a Password Reset email once set and can log into Rugby Xplorer by entering your email and password.

Note:

- Individuals must be at least 13 years old to have a primary account. Please ensure parent/guardians create the primary account and then create a linked account for junior players. More information on linking accounts can be found https://example.com/here.
- If you have forgotten your password, click 'Forgot Password'. Check your email inbox/junk/spam folder for a link, then reset your password or request an SMS.

- If you have updated your email address on your My Account page, your new email address will become your username and your password will remain unchanged.
- If your email address has changed since you last logged in but you still remember the password, sign in with the old information then update your email address on your 'My Profile' page.
- If you don't remember your password, please contact your Customer Service team.
 Creating a new account with a new email address will create a duplicate profile and new Rugby ID which will affect your registration and accreditations.
- Some business networks block Rugby Xplorer. We suggest using a device not connected to that firewall. Where possible complete on a device with an alternate internet provider or via your mobile. You could also contact your IT department and ask them to mark Rugby Xplorer as a safe domain.
- If you have already signed up with another national, you will need an unique email to sign up to another one.
 - You can sign into your original account and update your email address.
 - Sign up to the new national with a new email address.

PLAY HQ REGISTRATIONS (HOCKEY):

Senior players and caregivers of junior players will be sent a link with their team allocation to register directly into their team.

If you or your child, does not have a PlayHQ log in, you will need to create this. You will only be required to create this once, when you have a login your details are saved year to year.

SPORTY REGISTRATIONS (NETBALL - CAMBRIDGE PLAYERS ONLY):

Senior players and caregivers of junior players will be sent a link to register with Sporty, linking directly to Cambridge Netball Centre. This is a requirement to play in Cambridge.
